Saturday 7th January

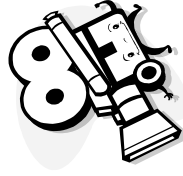
JANE EYRE (PG) 120 mins

Packed off to Lowood, a charity school run by the harsh and hypocritical Mr Brocklehurst (**Simon McBurney**), Her education completed, the teenage Jane (**Mia Wasikowska**) arrives at Thornfield to take up a post as governess. She is treated with kindness and respect by housekeeper Mrs. Fairfax (**Judi Dench**), and is intrigued and attracted to her employer Rochester (**Michael Fassbender**), but his dark moods are troubling to her, as are strange goings-on in the house – especially the off-limits attic.
