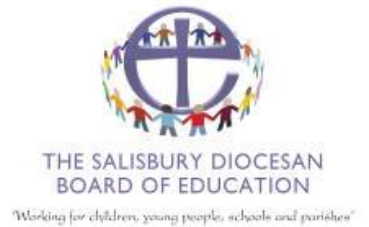


The Board of Education team – overview and contact details.



The Diocese

The Diocese of Salisbury extends over 2000 square miles, with a population of just under 860,000 and covers most of Dorset, including the unitary authority of Poole, three-quarters of Wiltshire and small parts of Hampshire and Devon. It is mainly rural with many small villages and a few areas of urban development. There are 4 Archdeaconries, 19 Deaneries, 155 Benefices and 460 parishes with 99 Voluntary Aided, 91 Voluntary Controlled, 1 Foundation School and 5 Academies.

The Board of Education

The Board is concerned to serve God in all aspects of the Church's educational work and thereby to enable people to develop spiritually, morally, socially and intellectually according to the beliefs of the Christian faith. Church schools are seen as central to the church's mission, so the Schools' Team seeks not only to fulfil its statutory duties, and monitor standards, but also to nurture and develop all involved in the life of its schools, believing that all are created in the image of God and uniquely gifted by Him.

Through the Diocesan Service Level Agreement, the Schools' Team offer tailored support to your specific needs. Our support includes:



- Support for church schools in all aspects of school leadership, management and governance .
- Extra support for new headteachers including their commissioning service – an opportunity to join together for a special occasion.
- Courses for headteachers, staff and governors, centrally and school-based, and sometimes in conjunction with LAs and other Dioceses
- Support for governors in all aspects of their role, including the appointment of headteachers and senior staff, and academy conversion.
- Resources and publications for teachers and governors
- Pastoral and professional support by telephone and email for church school headteachers and staff - celebrating the 'good times' & supporting the school in times of crisis
- Visits to discuss the schools' Statutory Inspection of Anglican Schools (SIAS) toolkit.
- Support and advice on Religious Education and Collective Worship
- Support and advice on developing pupils' spirituality, and on personal, social, and moral education
- Guidance on developing a Christian ethos and a Christian perspective on all aspects of the life of the school
- Advice on buildings and trusts (Voluntary Aided)
