Situated some ten miles or so west of Exeter and within the Dartmoor National Park, Middle Eggbear is a quiet oasis for rest and recuperation and yet is in striking distance of the coast and towns and cities in the county.

How it all started

Colonel R.A. G. (Bertie) Bingley C.V.O., D.S.O., O.B.E., set up the Eggbear Trust in 1964. Mindful of his own full, active and happy life - and very much in tune with his personal belief - he was resolved to 'give something back'. This he felt could best be accomplished by sharing his own home and his farm with those less fortunate.

To begin with, he welcomed clergy, particularly those from the mission field and in need of a holiday, into his home. As he became older and less able to look after others, he established The Caravan in the secluded old orchard at Middle Eggbear, as a holiday retreat. This caravan has now been replaced by two Finnish Log Homes

The Trustees share his vision and maintain The Lodges to provide free holidays for those who qualify under the terms of the Trust.

Accommodation

The two Lodges enjoy views over Dartmoor and comprise three bedrooms: one bedroom with a double bed and ensuite bathroom, one with two single beds and then the third has bunk beds. There is also a family bathroom. The spacious kitchen is incorporated in the living room. Each Lodge is equipped to cater for six people. The Lodges are all electric and are on mains water. A 'games room' is close by for youngsters on wet days!

The Trustees ask for a non-returnable booking fee of £20 which is put towards the cost of electricity during your stay.
