All requests will be considered with regards to the needs and situation of the individual, however we do not provide personal care or help with domestic chores.

HOW THE SCHEME WORKS

Requests for support can be made by telephone, email or letter.

The Neighbour should be aware of the request.

The request will be assessed and if we are able to help a visit will be arranged.

The Admin Team can deal with queries from Neighbours and Angels during our office opening hours. When the office is closed there is an answer-phone and messages are checked daily. There is an additional number for use in an emergency.
