“Please do not grow tired of praying for Sudan” (Archbishop Ezekiel)

There is much to be thankful for this month. Peace talks continue between the government and SPLM North, and we may reflect “better jaw jaw than war war” as Sir Winston Churchill said, but we must add that it is better still that peace may be agreed and embraced at every level of society.

Peace Primary School continues to thrive as it approaches the end of term. Some of the children are sitting for their Sudan Primary Certificate, and we pray they will pass with flying colours. Teachers and support staff are very committed and enjoy the backing of the parents. The school also has several orphans, and they are particularly grateful that they are not neglected but given free education; teachers are encouraging them to take their studies seriously so they can achieve their dreams.

Bradford Deanery (Wiltshire) is sending money to enable a kindergarten unit to be built.

Rooted in Jesus continues to go forward. Babuj has stepped down from his Diocesan Secretary role and is concentrating on Rooted in Jesus. This seems to have energised the church, and Babuj was able to encourage the believers in Salara district. Pastor Hassan Sudan (below) has visited a couple of hitherto neglected places.
