Harvest Resources

The Church Urban Fund has released free resources for Harvest.

The resources, based on Matthew 9:38 – calling workers to the harvest - is a celebration of the more than 13,000 people around the country, who have taken up this call, and who volunteer their time at Church Urban Fund-supported social action projects.

The resources include stories such as that of Mary.

Mary is a single mum, has lived on her estate in south London for more than 20 years, and in that time has seen many changes, but through it all she has been a constant support to vulnerable families and children on the estate.

10 years she started a meal provision service to vulnerable children, largely self-funded, from her home. With support from Church Urban Fund she has been able to scale up the work as the need increased and now runs the project from a community space on the estate.

Through her work, she now supports up to 40 families and prepares 150 meals a week.

Matt Adcock from The Church Urban Fund says:

"You might know someone like Mary, or even be someone like Mary yourself, and that's why it's so important that we share these resources – to tell their stories and share the impact people like her are making in churches and communities, up and down the country."
