Send a Cow is looking for opportunities to partner with churches throughout Lent.

This March, Send a Cow is asking churches to hold a 'Lunch for Lent' to support the Living with Wildlife Appeal, in partnership with Tusk, working with vulnerable people and wildlife living in Northern Uganda.

And as part of the Living with Wildlife Appeal the UK government will match any donations between 15 January and 14 April 2020.

This means that every £1 raised at your Lunch for Lent event, another £1 will go towards the Living with Wildlife Appeal, helping vulnerable families in and around Murchison Falls National Park in Uganda, as well as supporting other similar work across Africa.

Raise just £100 and your church could help educate a family like Ujeni's on how to access safe and nutritious food whilst protecting wildlife in Northern Uganda.

Ujeni lives in northern Uganda with his wife Serena and their children. The whole family regularly skip meals as they struggle to find food, they have little income. The climate has changed and rains have become unreliable, it's difficult to grow crops. Serena collects and sells firewood earning between 40 and 60 pence each day. As their only source of income, it's not enough.

Use a Bible reflection and presentation to prompt your guests' discussions over your Lunch for Lent.
