Why did God send the flood and why did he want to save Noah and the animals? Each new school year is a new beginning for all of us, a fresh start. We can learn from the past and move on to better things. Reflect and share what we are leaving behind and how we will make the most of this new beginning. 9/9	Perseverance	The Hare and The Tortoise	<a href="#">Galatians 6:9</a>	Talk about our learning values – Tommy the Tough Tortoise and relate to the story. Can the class explain why a tortoise represents perseverance? Alternatively, tell the story of Robert the Bruce and the spider. Can the class give examples of a time when they've had to persevere to get the outcome they want? When does perseverance pay off? 16/9	Our Happy School	<a href="#">Abraham and Sarah</a>	<a href="#">Ecclesiastes 3:12-13</a>	Discuss what makes us happy in 'our toil,' in other words, our learning. When are we most happy in our work, and why should we be grateful? Watch a small part of <a href="#">this clip</a> and either make a comparison between schools, or discuss if these children are enjoying their learning. Do they seem happy? How can we tell? Reflect on how we can be happy in our learning? 'Happiness is not having what we want, but wanting what we have.' Make the link between happiness in our learning and the role of the school council. 30/9	Harvest – Trussell Trust	<a href="#">The Parable of the Sower/Farmer</a>	<a href="#">Matthew 13 1-9</a>	Sit down to enjoy a glass of water and talk to the class about how refreshing it is and how much you're enjoying it. How do they feel just watching listening? How could we all enjoy it? Share it together. Are they enjoying it more now? Explain that it feels good to have shared your enjoyment. Harvest is like this. 7/10	Wisdom	<a href="#">Story of the Two Rabbits</a>	<a href="#">Proverbs 1:8-9</a>	KS1 – Share the story of ' <a href="#">The Wisdom Necklace</a> ' using real examples from the class to personalize if possible. KS2 – Use the same story outline as for KS1 but insert example of people making wise choices in their learning or behaviour. Invite children to add a bead to the necklace and nominate an example. 14/10	Awe and Wonder	'I wonder' AH has book	<a href="#">Psalm 8:3-4</a>	Share an experience of awe, something that took your breath away. Explain what it was that made you feel this way. To feel awe we need to think deeply about whatever we are sensing and wonder about its existence.
